



The State of Florida Online Solar Rebate Application Checklist

Before you begin your online solar rebate application; please make sure you have the following items:

- Address where your rebate check will be sent;
- Address where your solar system was installed;
- Nine digit Federal Tax ID number (FEIN) of the company where you purchased your system;
- License number and type of license of your certified solar installer;
- Manufacturer of your solar system;
- Model number of your solar system;
- Date your solar system was installed;
- Total system installed price of your solar system;
- You will need to upload a copy of your invoice;
- You will need to upload a picture (jpeg format) of your installed solar system; and
- If you installed a photovoltaic system (PV wattage) or a commercial hot water heater (BTU), you will need the energy produced by your system.
